Security Infrastructure Loans

The Hebrew Free Loan Society (HFLS), in partnership with UJA-Federation of New York, provides interest-free loans of up to \$150,000 to help Jewish communal institutions finance upgrades to their security infrastructure.

What institutions qualify?

Jewish institutions serving New York City's five boroughs, Westchester, or Long Island are eligible to apply.

HFLS Security Infrastructure Loans are available to institutions regardless of whether they have security grants from the Department of Homeland Security, through application requirements differ.

How may the loan be used?

Loans must be used to enhance the institution's ability to prepare, prevent, and respond to terrorist attacks and security threats. Eligible purposes:

- Planning
- Equipment
- Training
- Physical infrastructure
